- 5 — Some families lived in incest.
- 6 — There were law suits & immorality.
- 7 — Several marriages were in conflict.
- 8 — Some practiced idolatry.
- 11-14 — Several were confused about worship.
- 15 — Some denied the resurrection.

II. The Source Of Disharmony

- 1:11-12 — They began to form factions.
- 3:1-4 — They acted like adult children.
- 4:18a — Their attitudes brought conflict and division.

III. The Picture Of Harmony

- They needed to know what love is.
- They needed to know what love is not.
- They needed to know what love would do.
- They needed to know what love would not do.

IV. The Example Of Harmony

- The under rowers followed the captain's beat.
- The under rowers pulled together.
