BRIDGING THE GAP

I. Bridges are built only out of necessity.

Genesis 3:22-23 - And the LORD God said, "The man has now become like one of us, knowing good and evil. He must not be allowed to reach out his hand and take also from the tree of life and eat, and live forever." So the LORD God banished him from the Garden of Eden to work the ground from which he had been taken.

II. You must trust that the bridge will support you all the way on your journey.

John 14:1, 5-6 - "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me." Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know where you are going, so how can we know the way?" Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

III. You must only cross a bridge with the complete confidence that you know what the bridge will ultimately lead you to.

John 3:16-17 - For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.
