I. GOD RESCUES US

IN SPITE OF OUR FAILURE. (2:2)

- Guilt — *"In my distress I called"*
- Remorse — *"From the depths of the grave"*

II. GOD RESCUES US

IN SPITE OF HIS JUDGMENT. (2:3-4)

- Discipline — *"You hurled me into the deep"*
- Severity — *"Your waves & breakers swept over me"*
- Holiness — *"I have been banished from your sight"*

III. GOD RESCUES US

AT JUST THE RIGHT TIME. (2:5-7)

- Danger — *"the deep" "the roots" "the pit"*
- Vulnerable — *"threatened" "surrounded"*
"wrapped" "barred"
"ebbing away"

IV. GOD RESCUES US

TO PUT US BACK ON COURSE. (2:8-10)

- Worship — *"I ... will sacrifice to you"*
- Decision — *"What I have vowed I will make good"*
- Mission — *"The Lord commanded the fish"*

LIVING THE MESSAGE

- The last thing we do — *"pray" (2:1)*
- The first thing God does — *"provide" (1:17)*
