



WHATEVER YOU DO Group Discussion Questions

Section One

1. Earlier Doug read John 14:12, where it says “anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.” What do you think that verse means?
2. Do you think this verse really means we’ll do greater things than what Jesus did, or is this verse just a figure of speech?
3. Doug mentioned that sometimes there’s a gap between what the Bible says we can be, and how we actually live. Do you see a gap like that in your own life? If so, why do you think that is?
4. Read Ephesians 3:20 as a group. According to this verse, why are we able to do great things?
5. What is this “mighty power” that the verse talks about? Do you see this kind of power in your life? Why or why not?
6. Do you ever feel like there’s stuff that God doesn’t want in your life but no matter how hard you try, you can’t get rid of it? According to Ephesians 3:20, who changes us?
7. Do you think there’s a way to live where God’s power works through us more often? If so, how?

Section Two

1. Doug talked about having a “God-folder.” What do you think that means?
2. The idea of the God-folder is that we divide life up into the “spiritual” and the “unspiritual” moments. What are some things that are easy to think of as being spiritual? What are some of the things that seem unspiritual?

3. How could some of the “unspiritual” things be opportunities to honor God?
4. Doug talked about the difference between being a spiritual cell phone and being a lamp. In your own words, what do you think this example means?
5. Do you feel like more of a cell phone or a lamp?
6. Doug said earlier that “God isn’t looking for the most intelligent person or the most attractive person or the funniest person. He’s looking for the person who is focused on worshipping Him.” Do you sometimes feel the pressure to be a “better Christian,” or do you ever have the feeling you’re not talented enough for God to use?
7. How do you think God sees you?
