

“And The Winner Is...”
(Ahab)

1 Kings 21:25-26 *25 There was never a man like Ahab, who sold himself to do evil in the eyes of the Lord, urged on by Jezebel his wife. 26 He behaved in the vilest manner by going after idols, like the Amorites the Lord drove out before Israel.*

25 Ahab, pushed by his wife Jezebel and in open defiance of God, set an all-time record in making big business of evil. 26 He indulged in outrageous obscenities in the world of idols, copying the Amorites whom God had earlier kicked out of Israelite territory.

(The Message)

Use your very, very, very best judgment in **choosing who you will marry.**

2 Cor 6:14-16 *14 Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness? 15 What harmony is there between Christ and Belial? What does a believer have in common with an unbeliever?*

1. Take God's **holiness seriously.**
2. Political leaders bless their people **when they honor God.**
