**Saul’s Emotional Reaction to David’s Success . . .**

1. **Anger**. vs.8
2. **Jealousy**. vs.9
3. **Fear**. vs.12, 15

In terms of motivation, David was **called**, but Saul was **driven**.

**What does it mean to have a heart that’s DRIVEN instead of CALLED?**

1. A driven person is most often gratified only by **accomplishment**.
2. A driven person is preoccupied with the **symbols of accomplishment**.
3. A driven person is usually caught up in the uncontrolled pursuit of **expansion**.
4. Driven people tend to have a limited regard for **integrity**.
5. Driven people often possess limited or undeveloped **people skills**.
6. Driven people tend to be **highly competitive**.
7. A driven person often possesses a volcanic force of **anger**.
8. Driven people are usually abnormally **busy**.
