Isaiah 6:1-8

TAKING THE "I" OUT OF WORSHIP

Taking the "I" out of worship means:

1. Our focus recognizes others, but centers on God.

"...I saw the Lord seated on a throne..." vs. 1

2. Our ability to worship originates in God, not in our own worthiness.

"Woe to me!" vs. 5

3. God Himself must act so that I can come into his presence and worship.

"...your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for." vs. 7

4. Any good that I do comes from Him.

"Here am I. Send me!" vs. 8
